Placemaking is about shaping places around the needs and aspirations of people who live, work and visit them. It is a collaborative process that brings together local knowledge, ideas and resources to improve public spaces, strengthen community ties, and support economic, social and environmental wellbeing.

The Shotton Place Making Action Plan has been shaped through extensive consultation with local residents, businesses, community groups, and service providers. Their insights and priorities have helped define a shared vision for Shotton's future.

This Action Plan (2025-2027) sets out a framework for delivery

based on the 10 priorities laid out in the Shotton Place Making Plan. It outlines 13 practical projects that local partners are committed to delivering. While the projects depend on funding from a range of sources that are not necessarily guaranteed, they reflect a strong, collective ambition to create positive change for Shotton by 2027.
